Barn Rules



Safety

- 1. Must sign waiver to use premises in any way
- 2. Not allowed to use premises unless currently boarding, are a guest of a boarder, or have approval from ownership
- 3. No use of pond without approval from ownership
- 4. Children 14 and under must be supervised at all times and wear a helmet when riding
- 5. Bring pets at risk of owner. If your pets cause a problem, they will not be allowed.
- 6. 15 mph speed limit on road to barn
- 7. Do not go on private property around barn facilities; if problems arise, report to ownership or call the police.

Conduct

- 1. Be kind and respectful at all times
- 2. No alcohol
- 3. No Smoking
- 4. No cooking/grilling
- 5. No cursing
- 6. Must follow barn hours: 5AM to 9PM (notify ownership if you need an exception)

Horse Care

- 1. Must feed and water horse daily
- 2. Stalls must be mucked daily
- 3. Horses may be turned out in the pasture daily, must be back in stall by 8pm. Contact owner for modified turnout / special accommodations.
- 4. Studs can be turned out, but must be supervised. Use Arena for turnout.
- 5. Must have updated COGGINS (EIA) test report on file.
- 6. If your horse is seriously sick or injured, you must take the horse to see a vet or a vet will be called.

Facility Maintenance

- 1. Follow manure dumping procedures
- 2. If you or your horse damage something, you will be required to repair/replace
- 3. Only horses allowed to be boarded
- 4. Horses only allowed in specific turn out areas, as per management.
- 5. You may be asked to clean out your stall at any time by management
- 6. All trash will be placed in trash cans or dumpster
- 7. Only barn related trash allowed to be dumped at the barn (no personal trash allowed)
- 8. Keep tack room neat and orderly.
- 9. Pick up any droppings from your horse in barn, walkways, stalls or washroom.
